THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT

As a parent, I commit to:

2. Parent will ensure that their child(ren) will abide by dress code and student code of conduct.
3. Supervise the amount of time my child spends watching television, playing video games, and monitor the quality of each.
4. Have high expectations for my child as an individual, and provide positive feedback.
5. Provide my child with a quiet area to complete his/her school work.
6. Support the teacher and ensure the completion of all homework assignments.
7. Attend parent/teacher conferences or meetings as needed.
8. Ensure my child respects all teachers, school personnel, students and property, including when riding on the bus.
9. Parents will ensure that their child(ren) will adhere to the anti-bullying initiative of our district.
10. Check my child's academic progress regularly by signing campus daily homework/ behavior chart calendar, accessing Home Access Center, and checking his/her backpack.
11. Talk to my child(ren) daily about academic gains and challenges.
12. Make contact with my child's teacher as needed.
13. Parents will communicate social/emotional needs to teachers, administrators, and counselor.

We encourage you to be involved parents in the following activities:

1. Attend educational sessions for parents.
2. Attend school events such as: honor assemblies, programs, and musical activities.
3. Volunteer in my child's classroom (read to class, present careers, art projects, etc).
4. Attend meetings sponsored by parent-teacher organizations (PTA).
