Olmito Elementary Family Engagement Policy 2019-2020

The faculty, parents, and community members of Olmito Elementary will develop a written policy for parental involvement during the development and review of the campus improvement plan.

1. The Parental Involvement Policy will be distributed to all students during the first nine weeks of the school year.
2. It will be the responsibility of school faculty to establish a two way communication process with parents and families regarding their children's academic progress. This should include, but not be limited to: progress reports, report cards, telephone calls, notes, newsletters, and e-mails, and school webpage. Parent teacher conferences will take place annually. During the conference, the child's progress will be discussed. The teacher will use the school-parent-student compact to show how it can support the student's success.
3. The school will make every effort to communicate academic and/or behavioral issues with all parents. This communication must be done in a language that can be understood by the parent.
4. Olmito Elementary will hold its annual Title I Programs meeting during the first 3 weeks to discuss Title I programs. All parents will be invited to attend at a time that is convenient to most parents. All parents will be encouraged to attend so they are informed of their school's participation under this Title I and to explain the requirements of this program and the right's of parents to be involved.
5. Parent meetings (such as: PTA's, Open Houses, Campus Parent Fairs, etc.) will be used to convey any necessary campus information to parents. Parent meetings (such as: PTO's, Open House, and whatever is listed) will be offered at flexible times such as morning or evening.
6. Parents will be given the opportunity to provide input and make recommendations regarding the Campus Improvement Plan, the Title 1 programs, and the Parent Involvement Policy through the Campus Advisory Council.
7. Parents will be given an opportunity to volunteer their services and serve on the campus parental involvement committee, such as PTA. Volunteer forms will be available at the receptionist area in the front office.
8. Parents will receive information regarding the school curriculum, school performance data, and student individual assessments. In addition, parents will be provided materials and training to help parents work with their children, such as literacy and the use of technology.
9. In order to meet the changing needs of our school, the Family Engagement Policy Plan will be reviewed and updated during the annual Campus Improvement Plan revision process.

Olmiteo Elementary Política de Involucramiento de Familias 2019-2020

6. A los padres se les dará la oportunidad de proveer sus puntos de vista sobre el Plan de Mejoramiento, programas de Título I, y la Política de Involucramiento a través del Concilio de Padres (PAC – Parent Advisory Council).
7. A los padres se les dará la oportunidad de participar como voluntarios en el comité de involucramiento de padres.
8. Los padres recibirán información sobre las guías académicas, datos del progreso de Olmiteo Elementary, y datos sobre los resultados de exámenes estatales de su hijo(a) anualmente.
9. Para satisfacer los continuos cambios necesarios de nuestra escuela, el Plan de Involucramiento de Familias será revisado durante la junta anual del Plan de Mejoramiento de Olmiteo Elementary.
